

NEWSPAPER ADVERTISEMENT FOR THE NORTH LEGACY TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR SUPPLEMENTAL STUDY

The Wasatch Front Regional Council (WFRC) is seeking a transportation engineering and planning firm to assist in the preparation of a supplement to the 2001 North Legacy Transportation Corridor Study in western Weber County. The objectives of the study are: (1) re-evaluate the location of the previously determined corridor alignment; (2) determine a logical northern terminus (1-15 connection); (3) confirm the corridor alignment width (footprint); and (4) evaluate and project the growth trends in western Weber County, and Weber County in general. The study is a cooperative effort between UDOT, the affected local governments, and WFRC, with WFRC managing the study. A consulting firm with transportation engineering and planning experience is needed to prepare the study on behalf of the organizations named.

We are requesting proposals from interested consulting firms. Consultant selection will be made primarily on the basis of the written proposals received as specified in the RFP and interviews, if necessary.
