

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (STIP) and the TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS (TIPs)

Notice is hereby given that the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT), the Wasatch Front Regional Council (WFRC), the Mountainland Association of Government (MAG), the Cache Metropolitan Planning Organization (CMPO) and the Dixie Metropolitan Planning Organization (DMPO) are seeking public review and comment on their respective proposed 2011-2016 Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) and the 2011-2016 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

The TIPs are a six-year program of highway, transit, and other transportation projects for Cache, Salt Lake, Davis, Utah, Washington and Weber Counties. The STIP is a six-year program of statewide projects. A draft of the proposed documents may be obtained by contacting UDOT, WFRC, MAG, CMPO or the Dixie MPO. A review and comment period on the proposed documents begins on July 3, 2010, and extends through August 7, 2010.
