| 1. Approval of August 8, 2008 Summary | Meeting summary was approved. | Approved |
| 2. TIP Business | <p>Report on Modifications to the 2009-2014 TIP - Ben Wuthrich, WFRC, distributed copies of a resolution amending the 2009-2014 TIP for information only. He reported that since the last TAC meeting in August 2008, WFRC received requests for modifications to the 2009-2014 TIP. Since none of the requests affected the STP or CMAQ programs the Regional Council reviewed and approved the request to modify the TIP in their meeting on October 23, 2008. The changes included additional funds for the pavement rehabilitation project on I-80 and funding adjustments to the SR-108 and SR-193 projects in Davis County. He then presented the list of recreational trail projects to define the funding line item in the 2009-2014 TIP.</p> <p>Following a brief discussion of the STP and CMAQ programs, Ben presented a request from Clinton City for an additional \$551,922 in Ogden/ Layton Urban STP funds for their project on 2000 West from 1300 North to 2300 North. The request for the additional funding is due to construction costs increase, fuel and asphalt cost adjustments and unexpected design changes</p> <p>2010-2015 TIP Input – Ben Wuthrich explained that letters of intent for the next TIP cycle are due October 30 (tomorrow). An e-mail message was previously sent to the cities regarding this schedule. | 3. ATMS Update | <p>Dian Williams of UDOT introduced the subject of Automated Traffic Management Systems (ATMS) and explained UDOT’s efforts in this area including the benefits of signal coordination and ramp metering. She then turned time to Mark Taylor of UDOT who gave a presentation of the specific benefits of signal coordination. There are about 1500 traffic signals in Utah, about 75% of which are connected to a signal coordination system. Through remote coordination, traffic issues can be addressed in real time, such as crashes, congestion, special events, construction, and even snow.</p> <p>For additional information contact Dian Williams at 887-3457, or e-mail dianwilliams@utah.gov</p> | Information only |

Traffic Management Sub-committee for TAC | <p>Wayne Bennion of WFRC reviewed a proposal to have Traffic Management sub-committees report to the TACs and include representatives from each city in order to encourage more involvement and interest from individual cities, and to better address signal timing issues and to develop long term CMAQ funding priorities. The Ogden/ Layton area will create a new Traffic Management Committee subcommittee since it is currently inactive.
