**MEETING SUMMARY**

<b>1. Meeting Summary</b>	Meeting summaries of January 27 and February 24, 2010 were presented for comment and approval.	Approved
<b>2. Traffic Management Sub-committee Report</b>	Alan Moss summarized the TMTC meeting that preceded the TAC meeting. ATMS benefits local communities with remote traffic signal control for emergency detours and alternative timing plans for varying traffic conditions. Some near-term expansions are to add all Layton and Kaysville signals and all freeway ramps to the ATMS.	Information only
<b>3. TIP Business</b>	<p><u>Project Status Report</u> – Ben Wuthrich of WFRC distributed spreadsheets of the existing Surface Transportation Program (STP) and Congestion Mitigation/ Air Quality (CMAQ) programs.</p> <p><u>Board Modifications to the 2010-2015 TIP</u> – Ben mentioned that WFRC received a request to move the next phase of the Riverdale Road project into the current year. Due to favorable bids and good construction practices, the next phase of the Riverdale Road project, Chimes View to Washington Blvd. will be constructed beginning in this Spring and will be completed by December 2010.</p> <p><u>2011-2016 TIP Schedule</u> - Ben reviewed the timeline for the 2011-2016 TIP. He mentioned that the STP and CMAQ project submittals will be presented at today's meeting for a recommendation of projects to go to the COG's and Trans Com for recommendation and approval from the Regional Council. Once the Draft STP and CMAQ programs are approved, they will be combined with the other programs creating the draft 2011-2016 TIP. Trans Com will then approve the document to go out for public review and comment during the month of July. A draft conformity determination will accompany the TIP. The TAC's, COG's, Trans Com and WFRC Council will review any comments and the final document before the Regional Council will take action for approval in August. The projects will then be included in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and sent to FHWA/FTA for review and approval by October 1, 2010.</p>	<p>Information only</p> <p>Approved</p>
<b>5. STP Projects</b>	<p>Ben Wuthrich distributed a summary of the submitted projects sorted by project type and criteria ranking. Ben reminded the committee that the project ranking is only one tool available to the committee for selecting and recommending projects for the draft programs. Ben then reviewed the merits and concerns with each project. The submitted project costs far exceed the \$7.3M available.</p> <p>Concerns were expressed that there were several I-15 projects competing for limited STP funds when freeways have other funds available that are not available to local government projects. Ben answered that improved freeways are an important component of a regional transportation network that allows local roads to function properly.</p> <p>After discussing several suggestions and project priorities, a draft recommendation was prepared that included three reconstruction project priorities: West Haven, box culvert project, replace and widen for (\$0.2M), Kaysville, 200 North; 900 West to</p>	Approved

	<p>Flint Street for (\$2.7M), and a Washington Terrace project on Adams Avenue; City limits to US-89 for (\$4.3M).</p> <p>Farmington then made a request that the TAC consider removing two Farmington City projects (Phase I &amp; II) of their Main Street (SR-106);Park Lane to Shepard Lane, reconstruction/ drainage improvement projects and including the Park Lane(SR-225) at Clark Lane and 1100 West reconstruction project for the same funding. The committee recommended approving the request. The TAC also recommended that WFRC staff keep the “project concept evaluation” files open so the remaining projects could be reviewed and possibly recommended in the next go around without having to duplicate all the work.</p>	
<b>4. CMAQ Projects</b>	<p>Kip Billings of WFRC reviewed the submitted CMAQ projects and distributed a summary and ranking of the projects. The 200N 300W project in Kaysville and the Wilson Lane project in West Haven are not eligible for CMAQ. The remaining submitted projects total \$12M, but only \$6.5M is available. After some discussion it was determined that the Harrison Blvd/Hwy-89 intersection project may not be eligible for CMAQ funds. Projects recommended to receive funds included the intersection projects along 500 South from I-15 to 200 West in Bountiful, additional funding for UTA Rideshare and UTA Van Pool programs, after some discussion the UDOT ATMS project for \$1.2M bringing the total cost of projects submitted to \$6.5M.</p>	Approved
