<p>1. Meeting Summary –March 14, 2007 – Salt Lake RGC TAC</p>	<p>Lesley Burns, Midvale City, made a motion to approve the meeting summary as written. <p>2. 2008 Natural Hazards Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan</p>	<p>Des Heyliger, WFRC, updated the committee on the 2008 Natural Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan. This plan is updated every five years, and is on the WFRC website, www.wfrc.org. Des handed out a brochure explaining the natural hazard mitigation process.</p> <p>Workshop on the mitigation strategies will be held on November 20th for Salt Lake County between 9am and Noon. Des asked that all planners should plan on attending and also noted that the workshops are open to the public.</p> <p>The 2008 Natural Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan is scheduled to be complete in February 2008.</p> <p>Please contact Des Heyliger at 363-4230 x104 for additional information.</p>	<p>None Required</p>
<p>3. Summary of Public Comments Received on Draft 2030 RTP</p>	<p>Sam Klemm, WFRC, reviewed comments received on the Draft 2030 RTP. Comments were submitted on the Mountain View Corridor, E/W travel, SR-111 transit, 5600 West transit, 11400 South Interchange, transit before highways, questioning the air quality analysis, and transit ridership projections. All comments are included and have been responded to by staff in the Wasatch Front Regional Transportation Plan: 2007-2030.</p> <p>Please contact Sam Klemm at 363-4230 x116 for additional information.</p>	<p>None Required</p>
<p>4. Review and Approval of Draft 2030 RTP – Highway Network and Transit Network</p>	<p>Val John Halford, WFRC, reviewed the Draft 2030 RTP. He handed out the draft highway and transit project lists. He noted that the draft was available on the WFRC website during the formal public comment period between April 6th and May 7th. A question was brought up about the Fort Union Blvd. project phase in the project list versus the map. WFRC will make this consistent on both. 700 West in South Jordan was also removed because it was not on the City Master Plan. He did note that there were a couple transit changes, one which would extend the enhanced bus on 3500 South from 7200 West to 8400 West.</p> <p>Val noted that the 2030 RTP is planned to be printed by the end of July, with hard copies and CD's being distributed in August.</p> <p>Greg Scott, WFRC, noted that the projects in the 2030 RTP are place holders and further study was needed for a more specific alignment and mode.</p> <p>John Bennett, GOPB, made a motion to recommend the Draft 2030 RTP be approved by the Regional Growth Committee, Larry Garner, South Salt Lake City, seconded the motion. <p>5. Air Quality Conformity Determination</p>	<p>Kip Billings, WFRC, handed out a summary of the Draft Air Quality Memorandum. Kip showed that Salt Lake County is in compliance with SIP standards for Carbon Monoxide (CO), Particulate Matter 10 ug (PM10), Nitrous Oxides (NOx), and Ozone for the 2030 RTP.</p> <p>Kip informed the committee that the new Particulate Matter standard, 2.5 ug (PM2.5), has a 35 ug/m³ maximum. The State DAQ is required to provide a plan to lower the PM2.5 levels in the Wasatch Front area in 2009.</p> <p>Please contact Kip Billings at 363-4230 x115 for additional information.</p>	<p>None Required</p>
<p>6. 2008 Baseline County Level Socioeconomic Projections</p>	<p>Scott Festin, WFRC, made a PowerPoint presentation on the 2008 baseline county level socioeconomic projections. He noted that the numbers in the presentation were preliminary and will change. More accurate numbers were presented the following week to the Regional Growth Committee. The last baseline projections were calculated in 2005. This list included rankings and scores that will help prioritize projects. Funding distribution was presented by county, sponsors, and project type. He noted that the Draft 2008 TIP will be taken to Trans Com in June. Ben also covered projects that have changed in past TIPs.
