2. Presentation: Science of Reflectivity	A.J. Kuhrmeyer of 3M presented information about the safety benefits of improved visibility of roadway signs. In the near future we will have a larger proportion of older drivers who will need improved sign visibility. Improved reflectivity has been documented to reduce accidents by 30-50%.	Information only
3. TIP Business	Ben Wuthrich of WFRC reviewed the TIP process for this year. STP and CMAQ project submittals will be presented at today's meeting so committee members will have the four weeks prior to the next TAC meeting to review the projects. The projects will be ranked at the March 24 th meeting at which time the committee will make a recommendation of projects to the COG and Trans Com.	Information only
4. CMAQ Projects	Kip Billings of WFRC reviewed the submitted CMAQ projects and distributed a summary of the projects submitted. WFRC requested further discussions with UTA regarding the TOD project and estimated benefits. WFRC staff also modified UTA's van acquisition request using a different evaluation form. WFRC will work with UTA to identify emission benefits of funds requested for rideshare.	Information only
5. STP Projects	<p>Ben Wuthrich of WFRC distributed concept evaluation forms and a summary of the project evaluations. If any changes are needed to the project information, project sponsors should contact Ben directly. Ben reminded the committee that the project ranking is only one tool available to the committee for selecting projects for the TIP; The evaluation criteria ranking is not the final decision as to which projects should be recommended to the COG and Trans Com. Field reviews of the projects will be scheduled in March.</p> <p>The TIP project evaluation process for 2010 differs slightly from 2009. As discussed at the January TAC meeting, greater weights were assigned to projects for ROW Preserved and Access Time Improved. Compensating reductions in project weights were made for Delay associated with the project. Also, Ben reminded the committee that they will have a full month to review the project list this year, whereas last year the committee was asked to make a recommendation based on their first and only review of the projects.</p>	Information only
