| <b>1. Approval of 02/05/12 Meeting Summary</b>  | Commissioner Jerry Hurst, Tooele County, made a motion to approve the December 5, 2011 meeting summary. Joel Kertamus, Grantsville City, seconded the motion and the Tooele Valley Rural Planning Organization (RPO) voted unanimously.   | Approved      |
| <b>2. Lakepoint Traffic Study</b>               | <p>Marge Rasmussen, UDOT, reported on a Lakepoint Traffic and Safety Study, called the SR-36 Safety Assessment, which looked at safety concerns between Sunset Lane and the I-80 eastbound on-ramp. She distributed a table and graphic of recommended mitigation measures and offered copies of the full report. The recommendations were categorized into short-term, intermediate, and long-term.</p> <p>Vern Loveless, Tooele County, suggested that a Mid-Valley Highway interchange could provide more relief and advantages over the long-term recommendation of reconstructing the SR-36 interchange.</p> <p>Marge said that UDOT hopes to find funding for several of the smaller near-term improvements.</p> <p><b>Please contact Marge Rasmussen at 801-887-3792 for additional information.</b></p>   | None Required |
| <b>3. SR-112 and SR-138 Corridor Agreements</b> | <p>Marge briefly talked about the SR-112 and SR-138 Corridor Agreements that were prepared two years ago. She discussed the importance of these agreements in guiding access management on both facilities. Generally, anticipated future signal spacing would be between ¼ mile and ½ mile. Paul Hansen, Tooele City, noted that Tooele City and UDOT had signed the SR-112 Corridor Agreement for the facility within the city boundaries. More coordination may be needed with Grantsville and Tooele County. | <b>4. Transit Ridership Update</b>              | <p>Christopher Chesnut, UTA, distributed charts showing fixed route ridership and total ridership over the past three years. Total boardings are approaching 1,000 each weekday, or about 500 people. The two new flex routes receive about 50-60 boardings each weekday.</p> <p><b>Please contact Christopher Chesnut at 801-237-1959 for additional information.</b></p>  | None Required |
| <b>5. Legislative Update</b>                    | <p>Wayne Bennion, WFRC, reviewed several potential State Legislative actions regarding transportation and related issues during the 2012 session. SB 46 would put in place additional protections for agricultural land that could make it difficult to construct needed transportation corridors. There is a proposal to adjust the third quarter cent local sales tax provisions so that those funds can be spent on urban collector facilities. Another bill would move the State Division of Housing and Community Development within the Department of Workforce Services. Other proposed legislation seeks to establish a task force to evaluate efforts to improve air quality in Utah. WFRC voted in favor of a resolution supporting this task force.</p> <p>Several questions were raised about the agricultural protection proposal. Committee members asked about B &amp; C Road Fund distribution and a feasibility study of a road between southwest Salt Lake County and Tooele Valley. Responses to these questions were later sent in an e-mail from WFRC. RPO members asked for more information regarding local sales tax options, which will be discussed at the next</p> | None Required |
