<b>1. Approval of 04/02/12 Meeting Summary</b>	<p>Joshua Maher, Tooele County, made a motion to approve the April 2, 2012 meeting summary. Kerry Beutler, Tooele County, seconded the motion and the Tooele Valley Rural Planning Organization (RPO) voted unanimously.</p>	<p>Approved</p>
<b>2. Mobility Management Priorities</b>	<p>Ali Oliver, WFRC, distributed summaries of the current round of applications for the Federal Transit Administration Section 5310, 5316, and 5317 Grant Programs. She also distributed and discussed the priorities recommended by the Tooele County Mobility Council.</p> <p>Ali reported that the Mobility Council is making progress in acquiring funding for the other components of providing mid-day service between Salt Lake and Tooele Counties for disadvantaged populations.</p> <p><b>Please contact Ali Oliver at 801-363-4230 x1105 for additional information.</b></p>	<p>None Required</p>
<b>3. New Population / Employment Forecasts</b>	<p>Scott Festin, WFRC, reviewed with the RPO the population and employment data he had e-mailed to the group. This included 2010 Census numbers and forecasts for 2020, 2030, and 2040 for each of the traffic analysis zones in Tooele Valley travel model area. RPO members asked questions about various numbers and corresponding revisions have since been made as appropriate. <b>4. Follow-up on Local Sales Tax Options</b>	<p>Wayne Bennion, WFRC, distributed material prepared by the Utah Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel regarding local option sales taxes for transportation. The 59-12-2213 tax was imposed by Tooele County many years ago and is used to support the public transit service provided by UTA. Either the -2214 or the -2216 tax may be imposed, but not both. Projects and services to be funded from -2216, including percent to highway and percent to transit, must be identified when the tax is imposed, and highway investments are limited to principal and minor arterials. Wayne distributed functional classification maps.</p> <p>The -2217 or the -2218 tax may be imposed, but not both. With the -2217 tax, minor collectors and above are eligible for highway improvements, and the project or service must be on a priority list created by the Tooele County COG, and approved by the Tooele County Commission.</p> <p><b>Please contact Wayne Bennion at 801-363-4230 x1112 for additional information.</b></p>	<p>None Required</p>
<b>5. Air Quality PM2.5 SIP Update</b>	<p>Kip Billings, WFRC, reported on the process for developing the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality. The State Division of Air Quality is responsible for developing the SIP and has suggested potential strategies for helping the State meet the new standard for particulate matter of 2.5 microns or less that was established by the Environmental Protection Agency a few years ago. One of the strategies DAQ is likely to recommend is emission testing on vehicles in Tooele and Box Elder Counties. There will be a public comment period on the proposed SIP in October.</p> <p>The committee also discussed how transportation projects throughout the entire non-attainment area are affected by the ability or inability to demonstrate conformity of transportation plans to the motor vehicle emission budgets established in the SIP.</p>	<p>None Required</p>
