MEETING SUMMARY**

1. Approval of 10/02/08 Meeting Summary	The October 2, 2008 meeting summary was approved with no changes.	Approved
2. Potential Legislation Affecting B & C Road Funds	<p>Lincoln Shurtz, Utah League of Cities and Towns, briefed the Tooele Valley RPO on potential legislation affecting B &amp; C road funds. He noted that currently about \$3.9 billion worth of projects have been deferred. He believes that a good portion of the projects will be funded through bonding, but he is not too confident that many new projects will receive funding.</p> <p>Lincoln covered some of the new funding sources being discussed. The Governor is recommending a \$22 per vehicle registration increase. The Legislature is also looking at increasing the gas tax as a possible funding source. The League of Cities and Towns is working with the Association of Counties on negotiations to split the funding increases between local and State projects.</p> <p>Lincoln also informed the RPO that the B&amp;C allocations might be reviewed to include road width along with the length. But this will probably only happen if funding is increased.</p> <p>Lincoln noted that he was available to inform the RPO on issues at their request.</p> <p><b>Please contact Lincoln Shurtz at 801-328-1601 for additional information.</b></p>	None Required
3. Planned Intra-valley Transit Service	<p>Steve Swan, UTA, updated the RPO on the planned Intra-valley Transit Service. He handed out a map of the proposed future service plan that will run between Grantsville City, Stansbury Park, and Tooele City provided by a Job Access Reverse Commute (JARC) grant. Steve noted that the new Intra-valley service will replace the existing Paratransit service. The new proposed service would also be a flex route, which allows for a ¾ mile deviation on either side of the route. This deviation would require 24 hr notice. He also handed out maps of the service between Salt Lake City and Tooele Valley. The Intra-valley service is expected to be implemented in April 2009. The new service will be reevaluated yearly, and grant applications to JARC will be also be submitted on a year to year basis.</p> <p>Steve also briefly discussed the possibility of dead heading buses in Tooele County.</p> <p>Wayne handed out an announcement of availability of FY2009 FTA grants through UDOT. 4. Functional Classification Update	<p>Peter Jager, UDOT, reported the results of the updated functional classification maps and invited comments. He handed out maps of the Tooele Valley area, Tooele City, and Grantsville City and discussed the changes made in the area. 5. Highway and Transit Priorities	<p>Jory Johner, WFRC, handed out the UDOT and UTA priority lists sent December 2007. He asked the RPO members if they wanted to reprioritize and add any projects to the lists. After a brief discussion, no major projects were added or moved in priority.
