MEETING SUMMARY**

1. Approval of 12/11/08 Meeting Summary	The December 11, 2008 meeting summary was approved with no changes.	Approved
2. SR-112 Update	<p>Jory Johner, WFRC, handed out a map of locations where UDOT is looking at improving the shoulder along SR-112. UDOT has identified approximately 8.5 miles of shoulders that may be improved. They have pulled core samples along the route and will determine what type of shoulder would best be suited. This shoulder project will be combined with a pavement preservation project that is scheduled for the upcoming Spring/Summer. Depending on how the estimates come back, more shoulder improvement could be added to the project.</p> <p>Questions and comments from the Committee are as follows: 1. Rogers Road needs to be looked at on both the North and South sides of the intersection, including possibly adding acceleration lanes and reworking the intersection; 2. What type of pavement preservation project is scheduled, and where will it be performed; and 3. What type of shoulder work is planned. 3. Corridor Preservation Funding	<p>Wayne Bennion, WFRC, discussed the \$10 vehicle registration fee that could be used for corridor preservation. He noted that in Tooele County about \$400,000 per year would be generated in the near term. The Tooele County Commissioners would impose the registration fee, the Tooele County Council of Governments would generate a priority list, and then the Commissioners would select projects. The funding could be used on either local and/or State projects. The State Tax Commission must be notified by April 1st for the fee to start being collected on July 1st. Wayne noted that after collecting the fee for one year, the County can decide to bond against the fee if desired.</p> <p>It would be significantly less expensive to purchase right-of-way sooner rather than later. 4. Mid-Valley Highway Functional Classification	<p>Peter Jager, UDOT, reported that the Mid-Valley Highway could be added to the functional classification system as a Minor Arterial. He handed out a map of the proposed functional classification map.</p> <p>Vern Loveless, Tooele County, said that after the EIS for the project is completed that the project may be built in segments, not all at once or to the full width. He recommended that the I-80 to SR-138 segment be the first priority, the SR-112 to SR-36 southern segment be the second priority, and the SR-36 to SR-112 segment be the third phase.</p> <p>Please contact Peter Jager at 801-965-4560 for additional information.</p>	None Required
5. Draft Census Tract and Block Group Boundaries	<p>Scott Festin, WFRC, reported on the Draft Census Tract and Block Group Boundaries. He noted that the Tract Boundaries have a population threshold of 1200 people and the Block Group Boundaries have a threshold of 600 people. Scott had sent out a map prior to the meeting for review. He noted that the red shaded areas are below the population thresholds. Some differences from previous boundaries are the refined block groups in the middle area of the Tooele Valley. The deadline for comments is March 1.
