2. Stansbury Park and Ride Update	Ben Inghish, PEC, updated the RPO on the Stansbury Park and Ride. He showed some photos of the progress of the project. They are currently paving the lot, pouring concrete for the bus loop later this week, and installing the light heads and poles by the end of October. 3. CMAQ Program	Robert Miles, UDOT Region 2, informed the RPO that no CMAQ applications were submitted. Robert briefly discussed the time frame for expenditure of the funds. Wayne Bennion and Robert will visit with each RPO member to discuss potential projects. Robert noted that in February 2014 another submittal period will be opened. Paul Hansen mentioned a park and ride lot at the south end of Tooele City. The current lot is part of property where the business is relocating. 4. Bicycle Facility Planning	Jory Johner, WFRC, reviewed the August RPO meeting discussion on the bicycle component of the Long Range Transportation Plan update. This included updating the existing base bicycle plan route type and location, updating and / or using the Bicycle Compatibility Index (BCI), and identifying priorities. Jory asked the committee for recommendations on criteria to use for identifying priority routes. Suggestions included the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Connectivity between existing routes • Identify generators and destinations • Identify routes that are for recreation, commuter trips, and short trips • ATVs and Equestrian • Deseret Peak Complex • Tooele Valley Parkway • SR-36 • Transit stops <p>Jory asked Tooele City, Tooele County, and Grantsville City to review the 2006 plan with their current City/County General Plans and identify any updates needed for both classification and existing/proposed routes, and to identify any priority routes preferred.</p> Please contact Jory Johner at 801-363-4250 x1110 at for additional information. 	<p>in Red have about 5 minutes of delay per vehicle per segment, Yellow have about 1.5 minutes of delay per vehicle per segment. Segment sizes are around ½ to ¾ miles in length. Wayne answered questions about the modeling and discussed with the RPO needs identified based on the delay information.
