1. Approval of 12/09/13 Meeting Summary	Paul Hansen, Tooele City, made a motion to approve the December 9, 2013 meeting summary. Commissioner Clegg, Tooele County, seconded the motion, and the committee voted unanimously.	Approved
2. 2040 Build/ No-build Analysis - Highways	<p>Wayne Bennion, WFRC, said that WFRC staff had modeled a 2040 interim highway build scenario for Tooele Valley to compare with the 2040 no-build scenario modeled last fall. He explained that the travel demand model is a macro level tool that is more for relative comparisons and regional evaluation than obtaining precise values on each road section. Wayne distributed maps of preliminary congestion levels for these two scenarios based on volume to capacity ratios, and a list of widened and new facilities in the interim build scenario.</p> <p>The comparison demonstrates the benefit of the northern section of the Midvalley Highway and interim improvements in the middle and southern sections, as well as congestion reductions from other planned street improvements. RPO members suggested a few additional corrections to the no-build network. They also pointed out desired changes to the interim build network. WFRC staff will incorporate these changes to the road networks, and also run the model with the full build of Midvalley Highway.</p> <p>Please contact Wayne Bennion at 801-363-4250 x1112 for more information.</p>	None Required

4. Transportation Topics at Utah Legislature	<p>Wayne distributed a handout listing bills relative to transportation that may receive attention at the Utah State Legislature's 2014 annual session. The majority relate to funding and air quality. The list also outlines concepts that have been discussed in recent months regarding transportation funding.
