1. Approval of 02/10/14 Meeting Summary	The February 10, 2014 meeting summary was corrected to clarify that an open house will be held to receive public input on the draft long range plan update. With this correction, Paul Hansen, Tooele City, made a motion to approve the February 10, 2014 meeting summary. Commissioner Clegg, Tooele County, seconded the motion, and the committee voted unanimously.	Approved
2. Emergency Management Center Presentation	Regina Nelson, Tooele County 9-1-1, shared a brief history of the Emergency Management Center, noting that the dispatch center handles all 911 calls. She reported that the Center appreciates the new connection to the UDOT Traffic Operations Center that was funded with CMAQ funds recommended by the RPO. They are able to use five cameras on SR-36 to be aware of weather concerns, update officers regarding vehicle locations, and other information. 3. Pedestrian Crossing of SR-138 in Stansbury Park	Commissioner Bruce Clegg, Tooele County, said that a group of citizens living north of SR-138 in Stansbury Park, want a crossing on SR-138 to be able to walk to the ball park, grocery store, and other destinations south of the highway. Daniel Page, UDOT Region 2, indicated that he can request a pedestrian crossing study. However, he has to wait until a year after the last study. It would be helpful to UDOT to receive local input on critical times or days of the week. Please contact Commissioner Clegg at 435-843-3150 for more information.	None Required
4. Updated Draft Bicycle Priority Routes	Wayne Bennion, WFRC, distributed a draft map of priority bicycle routes that had been updated based on input from the RPO. A few other changes were suggested during the meeting and these will be incorporated. Please contact Wayne Bennion at 801-363-4250 x1112 for more information.	None Required
5. Additional 2040 Highway Analysis	Wayne distributed maps with preliminary 2040 congestion levels for three scenarios: 1) no-build, 2) interim build, and 3) full build. Committee members noted a few network corrections needed on the full build. Other corrections had been incorporated into the interim build and no-build networks. The full build showed significant congestion reductions, with elimination of almost all severely congested segments. The RPO suggested that congestion levels be modeled for the year 2025. 6. Midvalley Highway Update	Tooele County is in the process of acquiring two parcels in the northern section of the Midvalley Highway Corridor. This will keep the EIS active. Please contact Blaine Gehring at 435-843-3274 for more information.	None Required
7. Oquirrh Connection Update	A group with representation from local jurisdictions in Tooele County and Salt Lake County met last week to discuss what is being referred to as the Oquirrh Connection. The group talked about the possibility of hiring a consultant to conduct a small study to determine objectives and issues in creating a stronger transportation facility	None Required
