General Budget

- As a Pilot program for 2014, the desire is to:
 - Have flexibility
 - Help lots of communities
 - Stretch the dollars
- 400K proposed budget
 - WFRC staff / consultant assistance (\$250,000)
 - Direct financial assistance (\$150,000)



Types of Projects Contemplated

1. Capacity building
2. Technical assistance
3. Multijurisdictional projects
 - E.g., a Corridor plan
4. Comprehensive plans, either in whole or in part
5. Implementing previously-adopted plans
 - E.g., new zoning
6. Public participation
7. Studies such as housing or market studies.



Selecting Projects

Aim is to try to help lots of communities
Not all assistance is project based

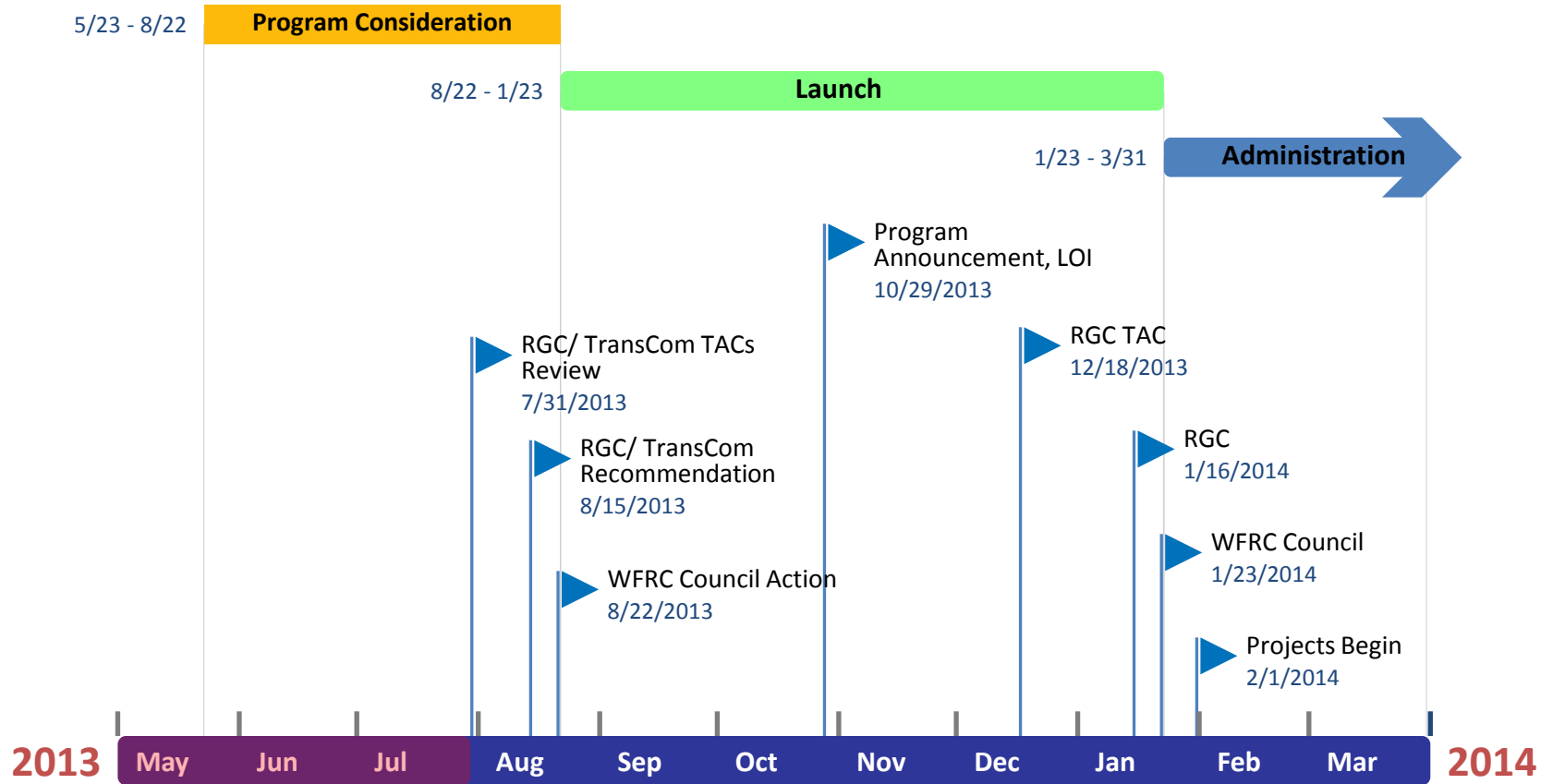
General selection considerations:

- Have a local match?
