1. <b>Approval of 06/09/14 Meeting Summary</b>	Mayor Brent Marshall made a motion to approve the June 9, 2014 meeting summary. Commissioner Jerry Hurst seconded the motion, and the committee voted unanimously.	Approved
2. <b>Transit Plan Elements</b>	Alma Haskell, UTA, distributed ridership information for the past few years on existing transit routes. He also shared a draft list of short, intermediate, and long term transit plans and asked for input. Key elements include pursuing strategies to increase ridership for all UTA modes and improving operational efficiencies. 3. <b>ITS Plan Elements</b>	Chris Siavrakas, UDOT Traffic Management Division, discussed elements of the existing ITS plan for Tooele Valley, such as message signs, cameras, and monitoring stations. He distributed a list of approximate costs for various elements. Chris invited thoughts on how to update the existing plan. 4. <b>Safety Plan Elements</b>	Wayne Bennion, WFRC, asked if an approach similar to the approach with updating the ITS plan would work and RPO members suggested it would. 5. <b>Traffic Signal Performance Metrics</b>	Mark Taylor, UDOT TOC, said that in 2011, UDOT leadership had challenged the traffic management division to develop a world class signal system. Over the past few years, UDOT has worked primarily with Purdue University and been able to develop the ability to automatically generate key performance metrics that allow signal timing updates to made much more frequently than previously. For example, through recent signal optimization efforts along SR-36, percent arrivals on green have increased from 71% to 86%.  <b>Please contact Mark Taylor at 801-887-3714 for more information.</b>	None Required
